OUR NEEDS FOR 2026

As you consider your giving for 2026, we want to lift up the ways that your giving helps us step into shared abundance for the year ahead:

STAFF SUPPORT: We have a wonderful staff of gifted individuals who work hard to support the meaningful ministry that happens at Burke UMC. For us to support them as the cost of living rises, and the building and ministries continue to expand, we must also increase the congregation's giving. Staff salaries are a large part of our budget and are funded solely by the generosity of our congregation.

PROGRAM MINISTRIES: From Burke Gives Back to social justice site visits to gathering often for times of fellowship, our Care, Learn, Share, and Worship ministries reflect what it means to be a church full of disciples of Jesus Christ. Your gifts make it possible to fund vital program ministries that touch the lives, within our congregation and our wider community.

CARE FOR THE BUILDING: Another significant portion of our budget is maintaining our church building. While we have been fortunate to receive a significant grant from the NoVa District to cover the cost of our kitchen renovation, the day-to-day upkeep relies on your generous gifts. As the building is used more often, it becomes even more important to keep it well-maintained and welcoming for all who gather here.

















WAYS WE DISCERN GIVING

In discerning your giving for 2026, here are some considerations and questions that may help guide your reflection.



Giving financially to further the work of Christ in the world is a meaningful part of how we live out our faith. Grounded in that faith, we're called to embody God's love and grace in all we do. Because we believe the church is the Body of Christ in the world, giving to the church becomes a tangible way to live out that belief. When our faith is rooted in generosity, giving becomes a practice of recognizing the abundance we receive from God.

BIBLICAL

Scripture speaks often about money, particularly the blessing found in giving. In the church, we often look to the Biblical principle of tithing: the idea of offering 10% of what we have back to God. You might use this metric to consider your overall charitable giving or what you give specifically to the church. You'll find a tool on our website to help you calculate 10% of your household income or determine the percentage you currently give.

PRACTICAL

Many of us approach giving in response to tangible needs. Our proposed 2026 budget of \$1.23 million relies entirely on the generosity of our congregation. To continue our vibrant ministry offerings, we need everyone to give in generous and thoughtful ways. We know that each household's financial situation is different, and we invite you to reflect on how your giving aligns with your spending and priorities.

As we look to 2026, our proposed budget totals close to \$1.23 million. To support our vision, we hope to increase giving by \$100,000.

How do we plan to reach that goal? By inviting each household to prayerfully consider the amount outlined in your individual letter—or more, if you feel called. If everyone participates, we believe we can reach this goal together, without placing burden on a few or having to reduce our ministry offerings.
